• For many years the RadCon training within DOE and commercial facilities teaches us that with any exposure to radiation comes with it a slight risk of getting cancer. This is well known in the rad world. The chemical parity to RadCon is in that we have indications that low levels of Furans and Nitrosamines are unaffected by the chemical cartridge that was tested. Even though these Furans and Nitrosamines are well below OEL they are still a cancer causing chemicals. Whether they cause cancer or not, the chemicals are carcinogens and should be communicated to the work force. This could be an opportunity in our new CHAT class to communicate this.
