9. QUESTIONS FROM AUDIENCE CVST		
• Q: Full Tank Assessment (submitted at STC briefing) - Have you ever sent off a full tank core sample for off-site analysis?		
A: Julian Laurenz – Yes. A review performed by the Tank Waste Inventory & Characterization group found that core samples from tanks AN-104, AY-102, AZ-101, and C-106, were shipped to PNNL for analysis from 2000-2002.		
• Q: Continuous Monitor (submitted at STC briefing) - Is there continuous monitoring for mercury on stacks in AP Farm?		
A: We do not monitor continuously in or on the stack.		
• Q: Why don't we have people wearing personal monitors, will we use the summas, ion science cubs, and how C2Sense might fit into the picture?		
A: Parker Jones - This is something that WRPS has been working on getting. C2Sense is one of many different technologies that can be utilized as a personal monitor for Ammonia. There are multiple different types of monitors or sensors that are on the market. WRPS is looking into usability and all the logistics that come with it, including issuance, collection, calibration, sampling strategy and how to utilize and manage the data.
